Britton Featured in Superintendent Video

Nashville, Tenn.- Charlotte Britton of Surgoinsville was selected by Utrust as the featured superintendent in the 2010 Make a Difference video. Britton, who has been the Director of Schools in Hawkins County for over three years, was commended in the video by students, staff and board members for her qualities and efforts to make Hawkins County Schools a great place to work and learn.

“We continuously seek out school employees who make a difference in the lives of students,” said Dr. Dan Tollett, Utrust Administrator. “Charlotte Britton has made and continues to make a difference every day in Hawkins County Schools and in the lives of students and employees. She is clearly one of the state’s top five superintendents. Hawkins County is fortunate to have such a committed and capable superintendent,” continued Tollett, who retired as executive director of Tennessee School Boards Association after 25 years.

The video will be distributed to school systems across the state for use during the celebration of Superintendent Appreciation Day on November 18. It will also be added permanently to the Utrust Make a Difference Video Library. “We consider it a high honor for a person to have a video about them added to our library,” said David Jones of Hancock County, Chairman of the Utrust Board of Trustees. Charlotte Britton is only the second superintendent to be so honored.

Utrust is a statewide organization that promotes the school Employee Appreciation Program to honor various groups of school employees throughout the year. The program aims to develop student leadership and cultivate an attitude of gratitude in students as they recognize and express appreciation to school employees. For each of the eight appreciation days, Utrust produces a video.
