Sand & Sea Announcements. Use the announcements provided or create your own to inform the student body about Special Area Teachers Day.

Catch a Wave of Thanks. Decorate the doors of the special area teachers with a surfboard and write a message of thanks on the board..

Surf's Up Song. Enlist the chorus or a group of students to sing the rewritten song to the the special area teachers during the presentation.

High Tides & Good Vibes Messages. Use one of the messages provided or create your own to inform the community of Special Area Teachers Appreciation Day.

Life's is Better at the Beach Thanks. To have some fun, have students draw a beach ball, flip flops or other beach related item and write a note of thanks on it and give it to a special area teacher of choice.

Sand Bucket Goodies. Enlist a student or parent group to fill a decorated bag or inexpensive sand bucket with goodies for each special area teachers.

Fun in the Sun Presentation. Make the day special for the special area teachers by enlisting students to sing the song and say words of thanks. Invite a community or school group to provide a lunch for them.

Templates. Use the templates provided for water bottles and chocolate bars.

Artwork. Use the posters to inspire creativity to promote Special Area Teachers Day with the Sand & Sea theme throughout the school.







- 1. Distribute parts of the packet to the appropriate crew advisers (Action, Creative, Paparazzi).
- 2. Hold a planning meeting with the crew leaders to determine the following:
 - a. Decide the activities you will do for the appreciation day
 - b. Type of presentations (individual or group)
 - . Which students will fill which roles?
 - . Who will preside?
 - . Will the principal or assistant principal be present to make a few comments?
 - . Schedule a time for the presentation.
 - 3. Invite the principal or assistant principal to say some honoring words to the special area teachers on their special day.

Action Crew: Enlist a community group to provide theme-related luncheon items such as: Sandwiches with croissants with toothpick eyes (looks like crab) Fish and Chips (goldfish and potato chips)

Nutter butters made to look like flip flops

Creative Crew: Decorate a table(s) in the cafeteria for the luncheon with theme-related decorations such as small beach balls, small drink umbrellas, sunglasses, etc.

Make sure to have enough chairs in the circle for all the Special Area Teachers.

Action Crew. Invite all the Special Area Teachers to sit in a lounge chair in a circle wearing sunglasses.

Enlist all the A-Team students to dress in beach clothes with big floppy hats, sunglasses, Hawaiian shirts, etc.

Enlist a student to serve as MC. To get the presentation started in a fun way, have the MC do a small intro like "Welcome to a Day at the Beach. We are here today to honor our Special Area Teachers. And what better way to have a little fun in the sun than to play a little beach ball."

Play the Wipe Out song as background music for the next part of the presentation.

Place the A-Team students behind the circle of honorees. Use a blank beach ball for the A-Team students to toss around. The students can dance and have fun to the music while they wait for their turn. When the beach ball gets to each one, he or she will say something nice about his/her assigned Special Teacher. Continue until all the honorees are covered.

Next, throw the ball to the principals/assistant principals so they can say some nice things about the honorees after the students have said their thanks. (Be sure to let the principal/s know you're going to throw the ball to them so they can say nice things to the honorees)







- I. Put up the marquee message
- 2. Enlist 2 students to perform the announcements for 3 days.
- 3. Put the completed thank you beach ball in front of the decorated door or wall space of each Special Area Teacher.
- 4. Assign a Special Area Teacher to each classroom. Encourage students to draw and color a beach item on paper and write a thank you note to their assigned Special Area Teacher.
- 5. Collect the completed notes from all the teachers and put them in the Bucket of Thanks belonging to the Special Area Teacher.
- 6. Enlist a community or school group to fill the Sand Bucket Goodies..
- 7. Invite all the Special Area Teachers to a presentation and luncheon.
- 8. Dress in beach attire and participate in the presentation and luncheon.
- 9. Enlist a student to serve as MC of the presentation.
- 10. Play the Wipe Out song during the presentation.
- 11. Assign a Special Area Teacher to each A-Team student to come up with kind things to say about their assigned honoree during the presentation.
- 12. Invite the principal/assistant principal to say some kind things about the honorees during the presentation.
- 13. Enlist a community or school group to provide a luncheon for the honorees using theme-related items., if possible.
- 14. Find a group or individual to sing the rewritten song to the special area teachers.






